



The IMPULSE educational psychology module is designed to help caseworkers and managers to assess and access behavioural support for students where it is deemed appropriate. This is particularly beneficial for SEND students and referrals.

This module integrates with the Special Education Needs and Disabilities IMPULSE module to ensure that all professionals involved with a child are kept

informed, as well as the social inclusion module to monitor and support children after incidents such as an exclusion.

The educational psychology module allows for the management of referrals and work records. Referrals can be received and assigned to an educational psychologist which allows for tasks and actions to be tracked, the needs of each child to be defined and decisions and outcomes to be recorded.
